Course Description

This course is designed for Beginners and Junior Hairdressers to learn the basic cutting techniques, as well as for Hairdressers returning to the trade wanting to upskill and refresh their knowledge and skills within this sector.

Course Learning Outcomes

The Learner will be able to prepare, consult and perform the cutting shape to achieve the desired style.

Entry Requirements

All applicants must have some practical skills obtained through experience in a salon environment as well as basic knowledge of computer and internet usage.

Module 1: Preparing for a cutting service: The learner will be able to prepare self, client and working area for a cutting service. Consult and agree with the client to give the service.

Module 2: Providing a cutting service: The learner will be able to cut hair in various classic shapes - short rounded layers, square layers, parallel layers, natural inversion, classic bob, graduated bob, layered bob, curved graduation, and long graduation

Assessment Method

At the end of this course the learner will be assessed on theory and practice to obtain a final grade based on two tasks, as follows:

Task 1 -Written test on entire course subject matter (25% of total final mark)

Task 2 – 3 Practical Assessment on life models (75% of total final mark)
